#### 1. Upload Your Audio


Start by uploading your audio file, recording a live piece, or entering a YouTube link.

• Supported formats: .wav, .mp3, .mp4, .midi, .flac, and more.



## 2. Organize Your Transcriptions

All your transcriptions are saved in your **Songbook** for easy access and organization. Create new transcriptions or edit existing ones seamlessly.






#### 3. Select the Instruments


Choose the instrument(s) you want to transcribe. You can select up to **8 instruments**, or let Klangio auto-detect them for you.

• Options include Vocals, Piano, Guitar, Drums, Bass, Strings, Wind, and Synthesizer.



## 4. Choose Solo or Multi-Instrument Recording

Specify whether the song is a **solo recording** or contains multiple instruments for more accurate transcription.






## 5. View and Edit Your Transcription

Once processed, your transcription will appear as sheet music with options for:

- **Playback**: Listen to the original or generated sound.
- Edit Notes: Adjust time signatures, key, and notes using the built-in editor.



## 6. Export Your Transcription

Download your transcription in multiple formats:


- PDF (Sheet Music)
