

USER GUIDE - Sonic Bass ONE ^{v1.00}

This bass plugin is straightforward and easy to play, letting you get straight to making music.



Sonic Bass ONE

From top left to bottom right of the plugin's interface...

ABOUT button:

- This lets you check the plugin's underlying software version and developer info - in this case, Desired Sounds 😊

POLYPHONY MODE selector:

- Click for options - set the plugin to play single notes or many:
 - **Legato** (default) – single notes, where closely played notes don't retrigger the sound – try it and you'll see 😊
 - **Mono** - single notes, retriggered each time you play a note)
 - **Poly** - many notes – for playing harmonies or chords

SHOP button (top right):

- Takes you to the online store to buy Sonic BASS (ONE's big brother), or browse my other plugins 😊

“VISIT” & LOGO:

- Clicking the logo takes you to the shop (hey, I gotta get people there somehow 😊)

ACTIVE LED:

- Mostly aesthetic, but clicking it resets the MIDI and sound - it's a MIDI PANIC button

STRINGS and PICKUPS:

- These are for aesthetics only – not playable (aw, man)

TONE knob:

- Lets you roll off the top end (treble) for a warmer, deeper, duller sound (great for LoFi, for example)

VOL knob:

- Adjusts the plugin's volume or gain

BUILT-IN KEYBOARD (near center):

- Great for checking your sound (also animates when those particular notes are played)

GRAY BUTTON and CAPTION (bottom left):

- Shows the current plugin, e.g., Sonic Bass ONE
- Will also let you select new bass sounds if I add any in future releases

LED BUTTONS (bottom right):

- Click each to hear the plugin's name

VER NUMBER (bottom right):

- Displays the actual Sonic Bass ONE version number – this is what I update and refer to as I develop and improve the plugin

That's pretty much it. I hope you have fun!
