Accessing Presets in MuseScore

Many of the presets and playing techniques in MuseScore Studio are accessible through the **Staff Text** feature. To apply a playing technique, first

select the starting note for the technique, then assign Staff Text to it. Next, click on the speaker icon above the staff of the assigned note to open the Modify sound menu. From there, you can select the desired playing technique or preset. If there are more than eight techniques available, you may need to scroll to see all options.

Playback Details

Many of the sounds in this library are percussion-type such as the Gongs and will show a percussion map at the bottom of MuseScore Studio when entering notes.

Other sounds are chromatic instruments such as Synths and Pianos that are best used with a grand staff assigned to the instrument.

It may take some time to familiarize yourself with the sounds and what staff type to use, as there is no default staves for this library. This means you will need to assign a flute, percussion instrument or piano to your score and change the instrument in the mixer to an Ambience instrument afterwards.

(i) Tip 1: Ambience works well with long sustained sounds where the sound is able to evolve.

Tip 2: Layering sounds is another great way to create more complex sounds. Give it a try!
